

## Fall Institute 2020

The 2020 Fall Institute will be a blended model of virtual live sessions and offline coursework. The full institute runs from September 28-November 19 (with some offline assignments due by Dec 3). You can expect to be engaged in learning for a minimum of 6 hours per day. Institute is a full-time commitment.

### Institute Structure

#### Individual Offline Learning (70%)

- Begins on September 28
- Includes asynchronous courses- self paced courses to be completed each week
- Pre-work for live sessions including readings, video and practice
- Online learning modules including submitting videos of practice
- Weekly and daily deadlines

#### Live sessions (30%)

- Held via Zoom video conference
- Begin October 7 -Between the hours of 8:00-12:30 M-F
- Practitioners will attend 1- two-hour session per day.
- Daily schedule will be released September 25.
- A maximum of 4 hours absence (two days of live two-hour sessions) is allowed for the entirety of Institute. This includes all live sessions.
- Practitioners must be stationary and able to fully engage with web cameras on and minimal distraction for the entirety of the live session.

*\*Note: Dual Certified Special Education will have 2 additional live sessions per week*

### Institute Completion

In order to successfully complete LRCE Teach! Institute, practitioners must demonstrate proficiency on foundational teacher knowledge and skills. Assessments will be given weekly and practitioners must re-submit if the quality bar is not met.
